The supplementary council election will soon be held to find a replacement for Trevor Corbell. People interested in nominating have until Thursday 5 November to do so.

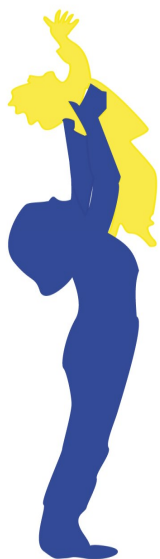

Speaking of Trevor Corbell, there was a well-attended farewell for him and Di at 68 on Main on Sunday 18 October. The NDRA gave Trevor a beautiful framed map of which was hand-coloured by C J Sandeman. It was done for the Nairne Community Action Association in 1981. Both Di and Trevor will be sadly missed given the huge contributions that they both made to our community. Until a new North Ward Councillor is elected the Mt Barker Council has asked the other North Ward elected members to all pitch in to cover the needs of Nairne residents. Already we have seen this in practice. So if you have any issues, just contact the Council.

Once the new councillor is announced there will be opportunities to meet and raise issues at the monthly meetings of the NDRA which are held at 7 pm on the 3rd Wednesday of each month in Nairne Uniting Church Hall, Allargue Street. The first 30-45 minutes alternate between a guest speaker one month and the next month a councillor forum. At the forum there will be ample opportunity to talk with the newly elected councillor. The next councillor forum will be in early 2016.

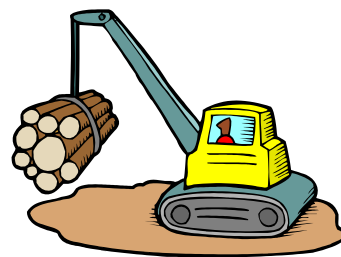

Layby is available to secure some of the handmade treasures which may not be readily available later in the year.

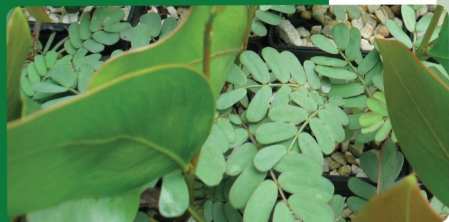

Christmas Alone

Are you facing Christmas alone – for the first time, or again? I find it interesting how we measure our lives by the next Christmas coming up. People seem to talk about it and plan for so long. And it can be embarrassing for everyone when you are responding for the twenty seventh time – “nothing”, when people cheerfully say “and what are you doing for Christmas?” There are all sorts of reasons that people spend Christmas alone. Often it’s not your preferred choice - there may have been a death, a separation, you moved or your family moved.

It might be difficult, but the best thing you can do for yourself is to make a plan. If you have a plan, you can answer that inevitable question with confidence. You will be able to resist those invitations from others that you really don’t want to take. Your plan might be different to any other Christmas you ever had, but it can be completely your choice.

- If you would love to spend Christmas alone – go for it. Decide how you will spend the day and don’t let others tell you how you ‘should’ be spending it.
- If you have friends who are going away, ask them if you can house sit for them and perhaps you can pretend you are on holiday. If you want to be left alone, don’t tell people what your plan is – just that you have one and that you will be away.
- If you can afford it, go for a holiday. Flights are sometimes much cheaper and easier to get on Christmas Day.
- If you are sick of the traditional way of celebrating, develop your own way. Maybe you would like to decorate your house with Australian greenery and flowers instead of the usual lights and tinsel. Maybe you would like to rearrange the furniture or redecorate.
- If you think that everyone else is having a wonderful time, remind yourself that Christmas is one of the most stressful times of the year for relationships.

- Give yourself a great gift. You may have to scour eBay or op-shops, but get yourself something special, wrap it and open it on Christmas Day - or Christmas Eve, or even Boxing Day! You choose.
- If you want to spend some time in the day crying, give yourself time limits or appointment times for the tears, say at 10 am for half an hour, and 4 pm for fifteen minutes. Get yourself occupied with something absorbing beforehand and you might miss your appointments!
- Buy some treats to eat and/or drink on the day. If you love to cook, try an exotic recipe.
- If you want to be around people but don't want to talk about yourself, find a charity that is providing a Christmas meal on the day. They will be grateful for your hands and help. Most helpers will have their own reasons for being there and you will find that everyone is too busy to be chatting.

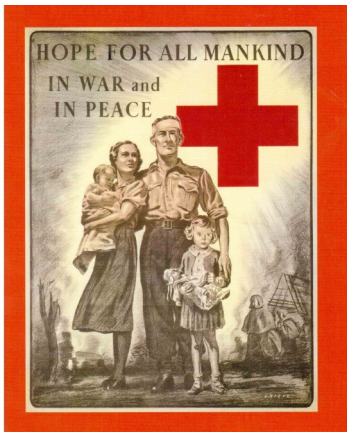

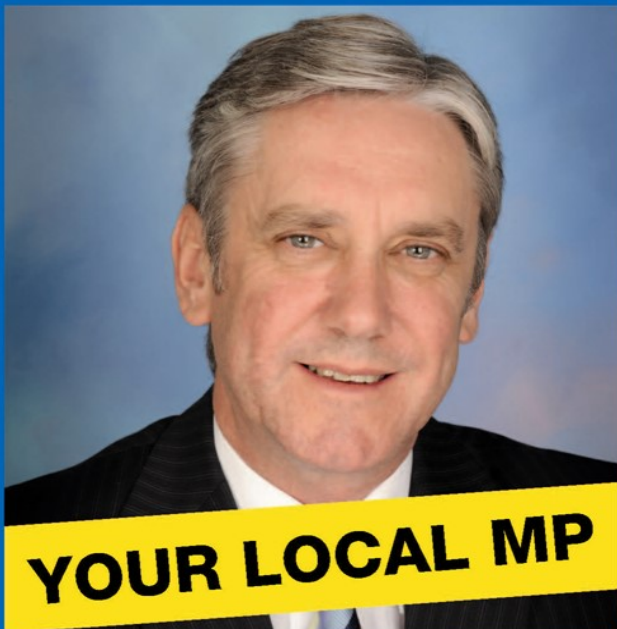
